Purpose: Forks Soccer Club (FSC) strives to provide a safe, fun, and rewarding sports experience for all our participants, in an environment where kids can learn the values of competition, teamwork, discipline, and dedication while enjoying the game of soccer. The following Code of Conduct has been developed by the Forks Soccer Club (Board) to establish the conduct guidelines for Forks Soccer Club parents and players (Members) and to build an environment that will be safe, rewarding, and fun for all participants.

Conduct Guidelines: The following guidelines establish the minimum level of parent and player conduct while participating as a Member of Forks Soccer Club. These guidelines are not all-inclusive – the Forks Soccer Club reserves the right to discipline parents or players if it is deemed that their behavior is hurtful, intolerant, unfair, or otherwise detrimental to the Club’s Members or our good standing in the youth soccer community.

FSC Parents and Players - I agree to:

1. Abide by all applicable league and FSC regulations while participating at any FSC event.
2. Abide by all local laws and ordinances while attending any FSC event.
3. Never engage in intimidation, harassment, bullying or hazing of any kind.
4. Never engage in abusive or foul language while at any Forks Soccer Club event.
5. Never openly criticize a player for making a mistake at any time.
6. Never openly criticize the judgement or ruling of a referee while at a Forks Soccer Club game.
7. Never engage in excessive horseplay, teasing, pranks, or stunts of any kind.
8. Always treat other players, parents and coaches with dignity, respect, and tolerance.
9. Foster an atmosphere of competition, discipline, fun, and success for our Club.
10. Refrain from the use of all alcohol, tobacco, or drugs at any Forks Soccer Club sporting event.
11. Notify FSC coaches of any health and/or safety issue that I or my child may have.
12. Notify an FSC coach or Board Member of any unsafe or harmful situation at any FSC event.
13. Learn all of the applicable rules of the game, and wear the correct uniform and safety gear.
14. Demonstrate sportsmanship and integrity and act as a mentor for junior players on my team.
15. Work to attend games and practices - notify the coach if I am going to be absent or late.

FSC Parents and Players - I understand that not following the Code of Conduct can result in:

1. A written warning of misconduct from the FSC Board members.
2. Suspension of competition in practice(s) or game(s) as determined by the FSC board members.
3. Fines and suspensions as determined by the League regulations and/or FSC Bylaws.
4. Being ejected or banned from a Forks Soccer Club event.
5. Revocation of my Forks Soccer Club membership.
